

Humanities/Social Science Credit Hours

Clusters are sets of related courses. A cluster contains a minimum of twelve credits of coursework, which is equivalent, in most cases, to three courses. An approved cluster in the CHE department falls within two of the academic divisions: Humanities, Social Sciences. An additional 8 credits, which is equivalent, in most cases, to two courses, are required in the opposite division of the chosen cluster.

Example:

12 credits in the Humanities division
+
8 credits in the Social Science division

OR

12 credits in the Social Science division
+
8 credits in the Humanities division
